UBUNTU is a Xhosa phrase which simply means "I am who I am, because of others", thus it is fitting that the underlying theme of this year's conference is the essence of Ubuntu and the will to volunteer. Thus, we invite you as a Wiki delegate to come on this tour, to discover the multicultural side of Cape Town and Interact with locals, with a tour that takes you thru District Six where forced removals changed the lives of many people under the Apartheid regimes Group Areas Act, to informal settlements which separated people based on the colour of their skin. On this tour we will visit the first township created in South Africa, under the Urban Areas Act of 1923, the township of Langa (established in 1927) named after King Langalibalele and other surrounding townships. We will visit important cultural places, interact with locals, visit traditional healers and visit a shebeen, where you'll have the option of tasting the traditional beer, which is organic and free of preservatives. You'll also get to visit the Noluthando Early Childhood Development Center in Langa, and here from the founder of the centre, Mrs Beauty Ngqakayi, the history of the center and how it came about to where it is today. This state of the art Early Childhood Development Center is where many "Wiki's" of the future will potentially be groomed, into being able to add value to South Africa and the rest of the world. This a must attend tour, for anyone's who's ever been interested in finding out more about South Africa's rich history and culture, and the transition the country has gone thru from being under Apartheid to a Post-Apartheid Nelson Mandela's "Rainbow Nation".
